

## Affidavit of Sponsor for International Students

In order for the Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student Status (Form I-20) to be issued, Shasta Bible College and Graduate School requires this Affidavit of Support. This is in compliance with regulations set forth by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for all international students planning to enter the United States to attend educational institutions. **The Affidavit of Support must include a letter from the sponsor's bank verifying the availability of sufficient funds in U.S. dollars.** The students are advised to obtain two sets of the affidavit of support and bank letter; please submit one to Shasta Bible College and Graduate School and keep the other for the F-1 visa application at the U.S. Embassy/Consulate.
