#### Desired Skills, Gift and Training:

We seek a preacher who will engage and challenge us and a pastor who will shepherd us on our spiritual journey, sometimes leading us, sometimes walking with us, and sometimes pushing us. We need someone who is relational and enjoys involvement in church activities. We seek someone whose preaching and worship leadership challenges us to live, grow, and act through our relationship with Jesus Christ. This person will be active in the local community, interested in making connections with other groups. We seek an advisor/counselor who is compassionate, empathetic, and experienced in interpersonal communication. This person would refer members to local community resources. We seek someone who demonstrates the fruits of the spirit emotionally and spiritually; is open to new ideas and experiences; is flexible, patient, kind, and humble; can tolerate mistakes in others and willingly seeks forgiveness. We seek someone who is hopeful and continues to mature and grow with the knowledge that no one is perfect, all are on a journey to be more like Christ. We desire a pastor who strives to see the best in people and situations.

#### Our Vision for Ministry:

We welcome all through our spirit of fellowship, primarily on a person-to-person basis. We seek to show Christ's acceptance and love to visitors, members, and the community. We seek to meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of our members. We want to provide members the opportunity to serve and worship in genuine and meaningful ways, trusting that this will reflect Christ's love. There is a large portion of the church who grew up attending Sunday School and are now seniors, serving as elders and deacons. We are 155 years old! Alongside are newer members, drawn by our openness, warmth, and fellowship. Some seek spiritual growth; others simply seek the care and comfort of a relationship with Christ and a church family. We seek a pastor who will both follow the Lectionary but still challenge us when the Spirit moves their sermon in a different direction. We are a 99% white congregation but would like to expand our ethnicities and our cultural awareness. We want to maintain traditions but keep up with the times. We are a highly educated, loving, caring group seeking a pastor who will get to know us one-on-one and in groups, and who will enjoy participating in our church events. We hope to be salt and light to our community—we hope to build personal relationships, ministering to those in need, and being a part of the solution to those in need.

# About our church and the needs of our community:

Our church is viewed by our community as among the more open-minded of Red Bluff's many churches. This is in the context of the conservative culture in rural northern California. Tehama County is driven by agriculture and recreation/tourism. We have a local hospital and community college campus. Situated along the Sacramento River, we have spectacular scenery and outdoor recreation such as boating, hunting, and fishing. Surrounded by lakes and mountains, there is hiking, snow sports, and water skiing nearby. While housing costs are a fraction of prices in urban areas, housing is unaffordable for a significant number in our county. Our county population is predominantly White (66%) and Hispanic (26%), and nearly 19% live below the poverty line. We would like to find ways to connect more with our Hispanic

neighbors. Outreach to our local community is strong. Members are active in various service organizations. Several social service organizations receive financial support through our Deacons Fund: Community Action Agency (Senior Nutrition), Mercy Foundation North (Women's Health), Salvation Army, the Family Counseling Center, and the Poor and the Homeless (PATH). For 20 years our church has worked with PATH, providing financial support, winter shelter in our buildings, and meal preparation support. We participate in a community consortium which is moving forward with PATH Plaza, a physical plant which will provide temporary housing and transitional services to the homeless.

# Our Team/Partnerships/Community Expectations:

The pastor will lead a team which includes a part-time secretary, part-time choir director, paid musicians, and contract cleaning and landscape services. The pastor will moderate Session meetings and liaise with various committees. Through community outreach and involvement, the Pastor will become a resource as we strive to serve our community. We want to call a pastor who is committed to engaging with members and the larger community. There is a need to reconnect with absent members and to inform the larger community of our ministries. We have a strong partnership with a local ministry to the homeless to which we devote time and finances. We have partnerships with Twelve-Step recovery groups. The congregation will continue to reach out to community groups looking for a supportive environment as they work on missions which are related to social justice. Another goal is to attract more 40- to 60-year-olds by incorporating music, worship, and teaching that are familiar to this demographic.
