Classes begin the first week of the semester.

**MONDAYS, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.— STUDIES IN REVELATION**—Taught by Professor Tom Meyer, this exegetical and expositional study of the New Testament book of Revelation will analyze major themes and give special attention to problem passages. Tom is known for his ability to quote scripture and heads a ministry call Wordsowers.

**TUESDAYS, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.— WORLD RELIGIONS**—Taught by Dr. Dan Iles, a missionary with JARON Ministries International, this class will cover the basic tenants of Hinduism, Islam, Buddhism, Judaism, Sikhism, Bahaim and animism. Special emphasis is placed on how to make bridges and connections with other faith groups so you can share your faith.

**WEDNESDAYS, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.—INTRODUCTION TO COUNSELING PSYCHOLOGY**—Taught by Professor Ron Bridges, this class will help the student understand problems and establish Biblical hope.

**THURSDAY, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.— SURVEY OF THEOLOGY**—Taught by Pastor Matt Kerr, this class is a survey of several major divisions of systematic theology including the study of sin, salvation, the church, angels and last things.

**THURSDAY, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.— PRINCIPLES OF CONFLICT RESOLUTION**—Taught by Professor Matt Silva, this class will help the student understand and apply how to Biblically resolve conflict.
